Dear Presidents,

At first I need to apologize for not being at the AG in Lignano on the 2nd of October, due to our flight that has been canceled and no any other flight was available to reach Venice before the end of the meeting.

Even if it was not planned during the AG to have a technical meeting it was my task to explain you all the details of the European Program.

As you know for the first time at the Twirling European Championship **the Level 1 will be required for all the competitors in Solo 1 Baton (Juvenile, Pre teen, Junior, Senior and Boys)**

WHICH LEVEL? ONLY LEVEL 1 FOR 2016

Explanation: Level 1 (**L1**) has two parts: the Twirling part (**T1**) and the Dance part (**D1**)

Both parts must be passed successfully in order to have the Level 1: **L1=T1+D1**

Level 1 is only basic in Twirling and in Dance.

HOW TO PASS THE EXAM?

To pass the exam: Each country must organize a clinic for the Level one.

That clinic must be conducted by one of the accredited teacher.

We have already a group of accredited teachers: you will find the list of the European Teachers below in the "Documents included"

WHAT TO DO IF YOU DON'T HAVE ANY ACCREDITED EUROPEAN TEACHERS IN YOUR COUNTRY:

Different possibilities:

-Ask for an accredited teacher from another country and organize a clinic

-Send your Competitors in a country where Clinic for Level 1 is organized.

-Send the National Teachers of your country to next European Clinic. (Information on separate document)

Who distribute the diploma?

In each country, one person must be dedicated to distribute the diploma to the athletes.

You will find the list of the dedicated persons in the "Documents included"

THE ACCREDITED TEACHER TASKS

After the clinic the teacher will send the report: a list of all the athletes who passed successfully the Level 1 to the person dedicated in the country that will print and send the diploma to the athletes.
